#### **Participatory Action Research**



We plan to do this through what is called "Participatory Action Research" This is a process of research that involves the candidates also becoming researchers, and part of an educational process. This kind of learning can be helpful in many different aspects of life and useful in many areas of interest.

All the research will remain the participants own property and can be destroyed at any time. Participants ID does not need to be known. This information will not only be useful to this project. There is no reason that it can not be used in a variety of ways hat could help to define projects or help to understand what the community cares about.

#### **Who How Why Where When**

The participatory action research project will begin late march 2014. We will engage with a whole series of ideas for collecting information, interviewing and videoing community activities. Work will centre round the community garden and other venues. We will organise walks, talks and historical tours. We will be inviting the community, local groups, college students, media outlets and interested parties to come on board. We will put an emphasis on not producing more work for people but using the work that has already done, before developing new stuff.
